






Peter the Great ruled 1682 – 1725 (43 years) Question 5.




Princess Dagmar of Denmark married into Russia's Romanov family in 1866. Who was her husband?

Alexander III








In 862 Rurik the Viking established the first state on the territory of Russia.





In 880 Prince Oleg moved the capital of the Rus' from Novgorod to Kiev. This was the start of Kievan Rus'.

In 988 upon the decision of Vladimir the Great, Kievan Rus' adopted Orthodox Christianity.




In 1547 Ivan IV, commonly known as Ivan the Terrible, became the first ruler to be crowned as Tsar of All Russia.

1812: One month after Napoleon entered a burning and deserted Moscow, the starving French army began a hasty retreat out of Russia.



The Romanov Dynasty ruled Russia from 1613 to 1917.






Peter I, called Peter the Great, was the founder of the Russian Empire.

Russia expanded its territory between 1689 and 1796 under Peter and Catherine the Greats.







Maria Feodorovna (1847 - 1928),christened Dagmar, was a Danish princess and **Empress of Russia** as spouse of **Tsar Alexander III**

The Russian Museum was opened in 1895, by a decree of Tsar Alexander III.



In 2006 the reburial of empress Maria Feodorovna, the mother of Russia's last tsar, took place in St. Petersburg in accordance with her

wishes.







The effects of World War I gave rise to the **Russian Revolution** of 1917, which caused the collapse of Imperial Russia and the end of the Romanov dynasty.

The siege of Leningrad lasted almost two and one-half years and cost the lives of an estimated 1,000,000 city

residents.



In 1989 the leaders of the world's superpowers, the USSR and the US, met in Malta for a summit which marked the end of the Cold War.





In 1991 the USSR broke up into 15 independent states.





Boris Yeltsin was the first President of the Russian Federation.

He served from 1991 to 1999.

Vladimir Putin is the current President of Russia.
